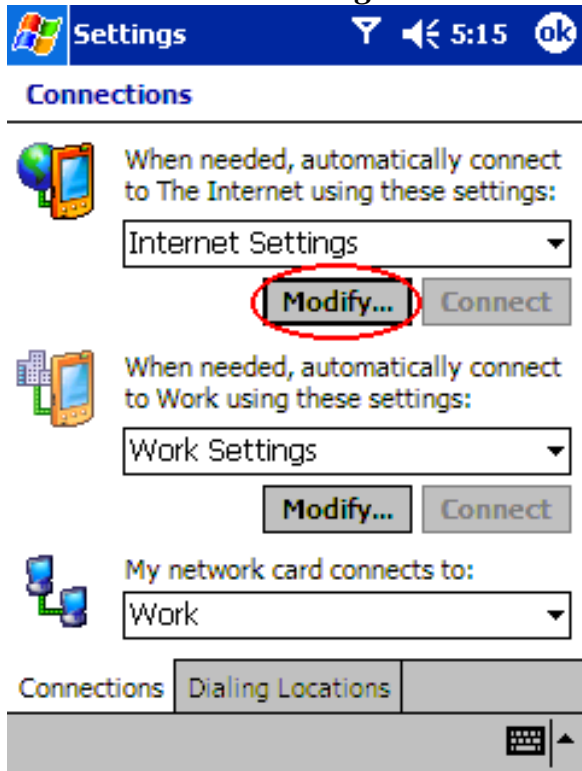


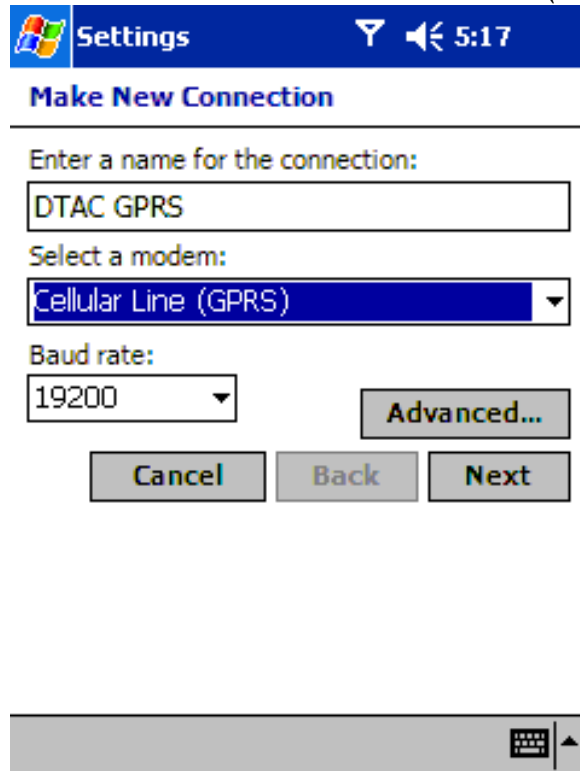
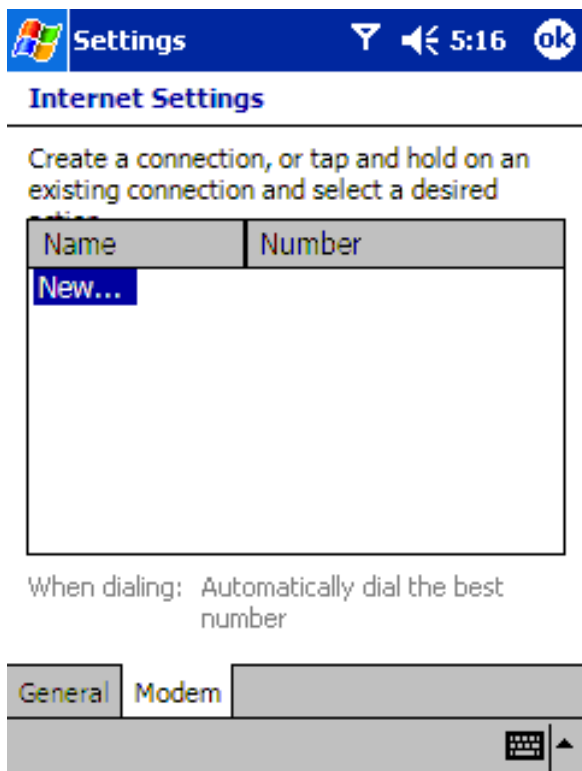
GPRS setting for Dtac

1. Click *Start* > *Settings* > *Connections* select *Internet Settings* click *Modify*



2. tap *Modem* tap *New..*

enter the connection name *DTAC GPRS* select modem to *Cellular Line (GPRS)*.



Click *Advanced..*

- select *Use software compression* & *Use IP header compression*
tap *Name Servers* select *Use specific server address* enter *DNS* to *203.155.33.1* & *Alt DNS* to *202.44.144.33* then *ok*

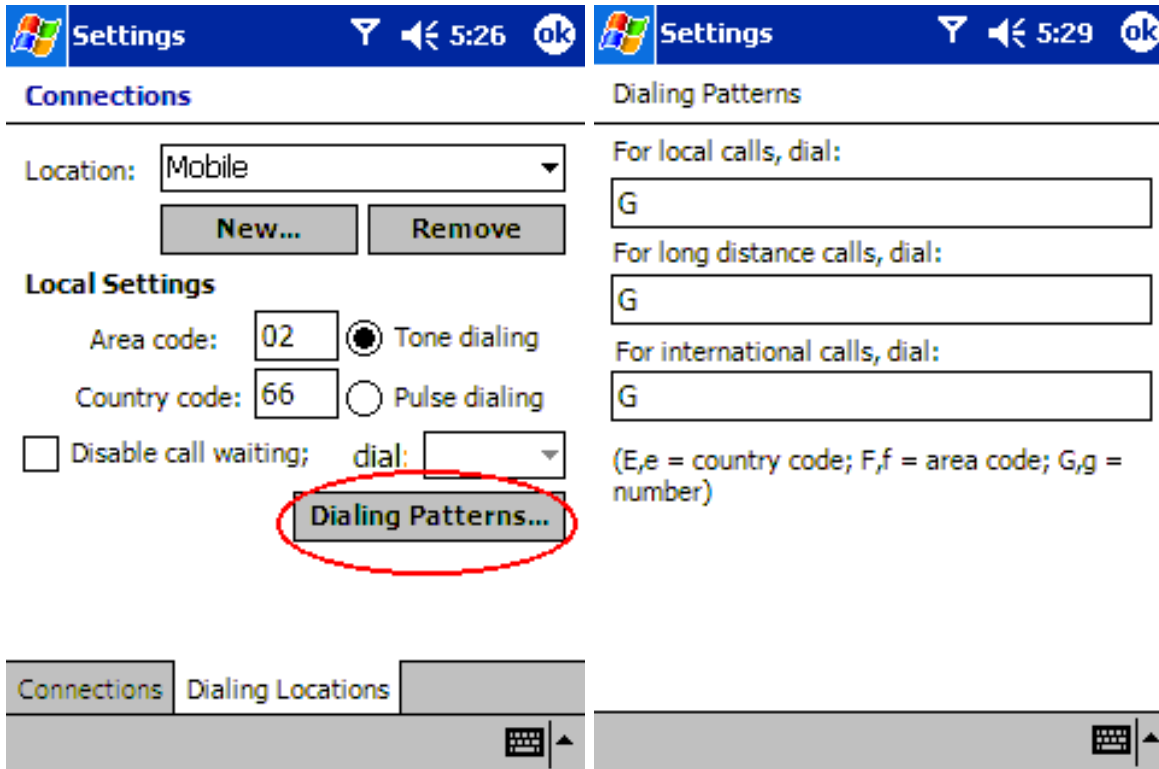

click *ok*



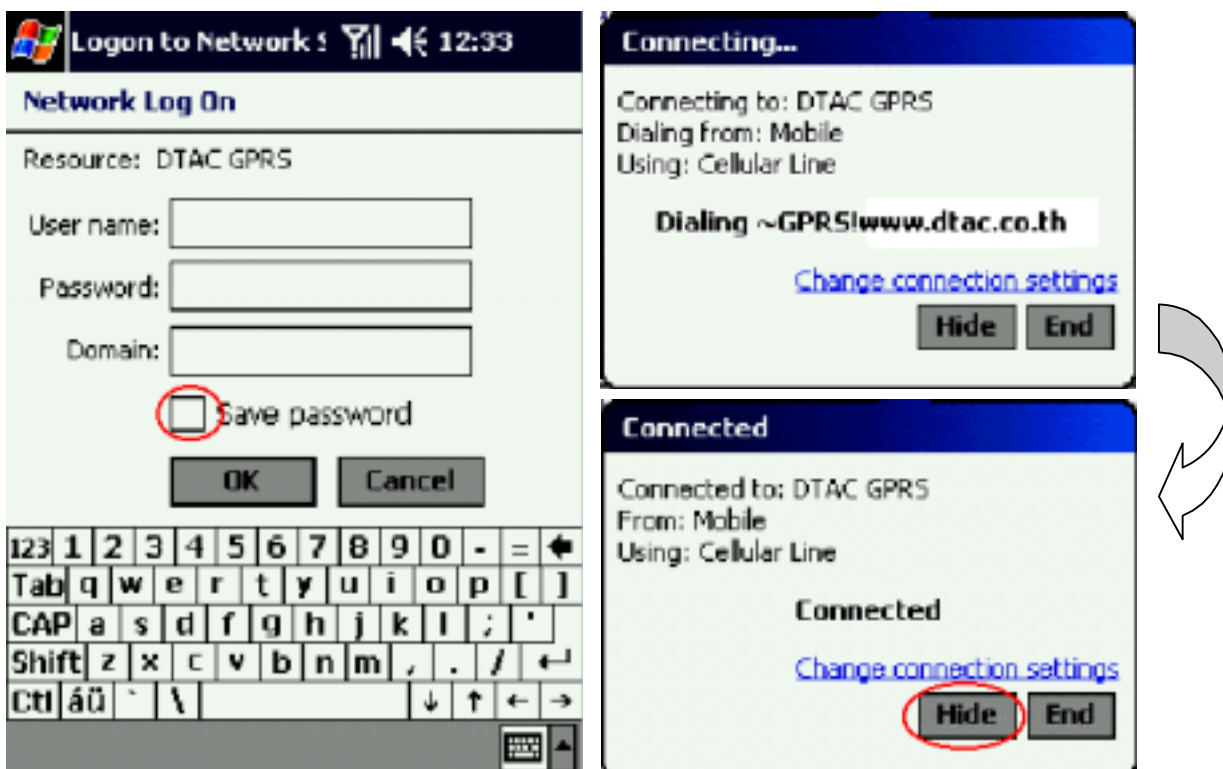
Now! Your XDA is ready to connect internet via DTAC GPRS.

1. Click *Start* > *Internet Explorer* connect to any website.



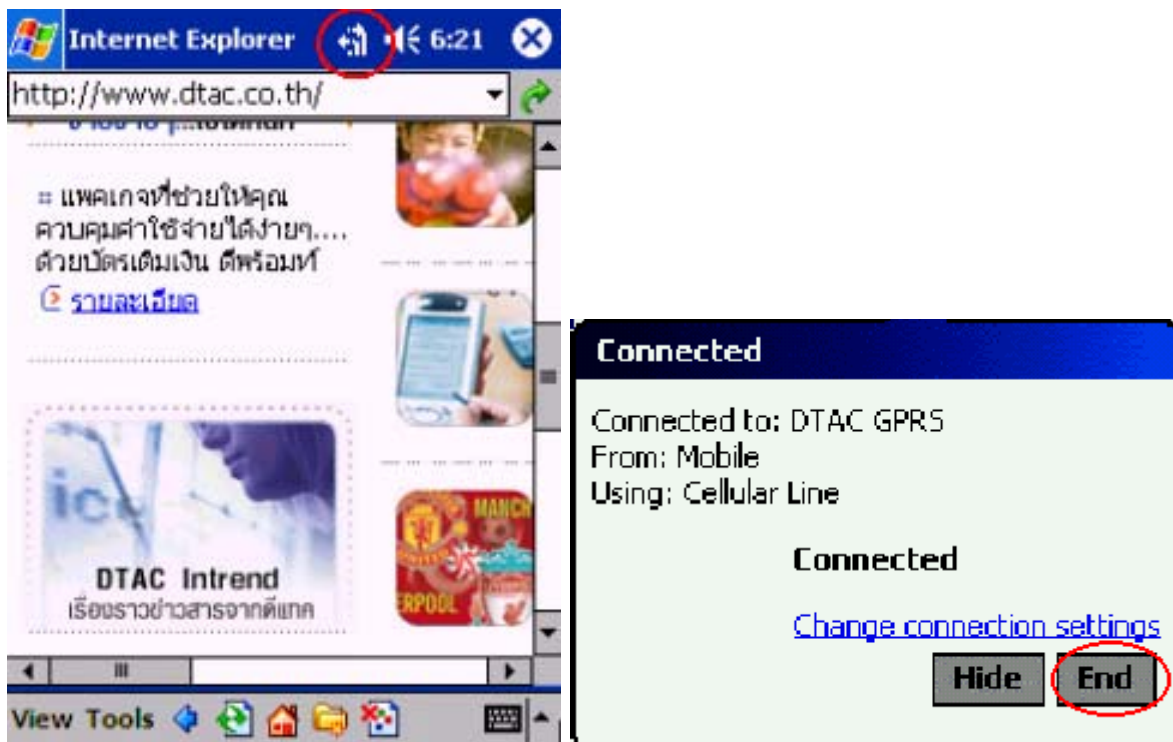
2. select *Save password* click *OK*
